## **Brushwood Center at Ryerson Woods**

Brushwood Center empowers military veterans wellbeing through a series of nature-based art and photography workshops, called At Ease. This program is offered at no charge to military veterans. Brushwood Center partners with the Captain James A. Lovell Federal Health Care Center to introduce veterans to photography, creative writing, and music in the pristine 565-acre Ryerson Woods.

The At Ease program provides monthly art workshops at Brushwood Center taught by a professional artist in collaboration with recreational therapists from the Lovell Center. At each session, approximately 15-20 veterans participate in the three-part day: 1) an art lesson about a specific technique (macrophotography, landscape, black and white, etc.), 2) outdoor walks and hikes to practice the lesson, and 3) a positive group critique with personalized attention to each participant. Brushwood Center features veteran work in an annual holiday exhibition, attended by veterans and their families.
